The Pastor's Two Bits...

Welcome to Fairfield Glade First Baptist Church! Thank you for choosing to worship with us today! I hope you have a great experience with God as you offer your prayers and praise.

Proverbs 29:18 says (KJV) *Where there is no vision, the people perish...*

This verse is not translated the same way in many modern Bible translations:

Where there is no vision, the people are unrestrained...(NASB)

Without revelation people run wild... (CSB)

Where there is no prophetic vision the people cast off restraint... (ESV)

When people do not accept divine guidance, they run wild... (NLT)

Where there is no revelation, people cast off restraint... (NIV)

But I still like the King James Version. The idea in modern translations seems to be fairly consistent... Without the guiding parameters of divine vision or revelation, there is no moral control. Several times in the Bible, just such situations existed. In Noah's day, just before the flood, people *did what was right in their own eyes*. In Judges, time after time, the same situation is described. In Romans 1, God gave people over to their own sins. The result of no restraint... they *perish*. They are forever lost from the grace of God. I like the KJV, *Where there is no vision, the people perish...* It just cuts to the chase.

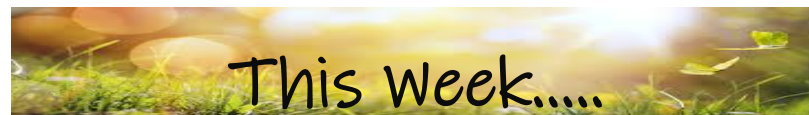
