The Pastor's Two Bits...

Welcome to Fairfield Glade First Baptist Church! Thank you for choosing to worship with us today! I hope you have a great experience with God as you offer your prayers and praise.

Prayer is a special gift from God. What I mean by that is this... God doesn't have to listen to our moanings and groanings. But He does. He gives us His time...and His ear... and His compassion. It's really a gift to be able to talk directly to the one and only God of the universe. It is a way that He gives Himself to us. Sadly, most of us do not take advantage of the privilege as much as we ought.

Prayer should be a two-way communication with God. When you pray, there are obviously things on your mind that you want to pray about. But often times, once you say your piece, it's done; it's over. Prayer should be two-way communication with God. He wants you to hear what He has to say in response. And that's when prayer can be challenging. How do you 'hear' from God? How do you know it's Him when you 'hear' it?

One good source of 'hearing' is the Bible. When you read the Bible consistently, you might be surprised how often you pray about something and the next thing you know, you are reading a Scripture that gives you the answer to your prayer. Whether it's your personal, quiet time with God or in a Bible study group, the Bible often guides you to answered prayer. There are other ways that God might answer prayer. It could be in the form of a special thought in your mind that you know comes from Him; it could be through a sermon or a 'chance' meeting with a friend. God has ways of talking to you. Faithful, fervent prayer just helps you hear Him better.
