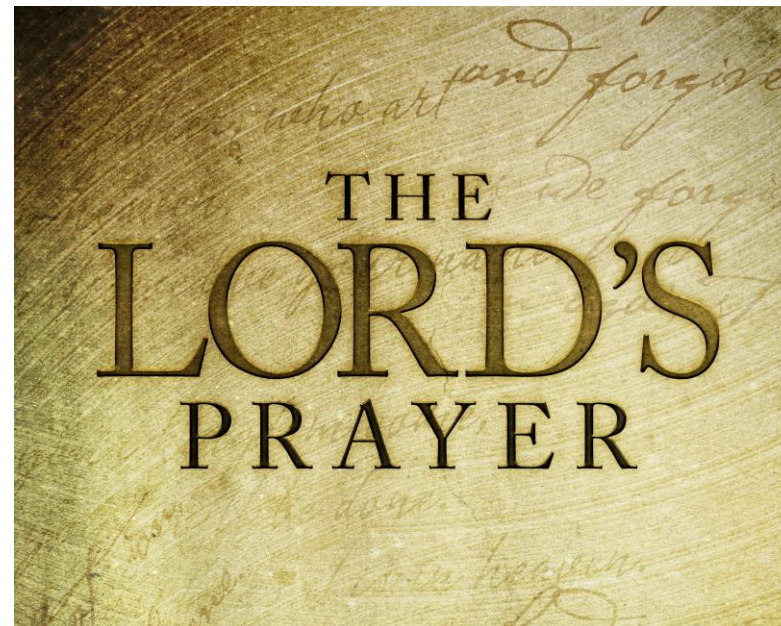

The Pastor's Two Bits...

Welcome to Fairfield Glade First Baptist Church! Thank you for choosing to worship with us today! I hope you have a great experience with God as you offer your prayers and praise.

Psalm 141:2 (NASB)

May my prayer be counted as incense before You; The lifting up of my hands as the evening offering.

God enjoys prayer. He enjoys hearing from you. Whether it is praising Him when you receive a blessing or crying to Him in a moment of tragedy, He wants to be part of your life. In the Old Testament days in which this Psalm was written, priests were commanded by God offer incense in the Temple twice every day and then also during special ceremonies. Every morning and every evening, incense were offered to the Lord. The aroma of incense was a powerful reminder of the presence and love of God.

May my prayer be counted as incense before You... Our prayers should be as regular and consistent as the Temple incense. Their aroma should linger in our minds and become so familiar that they draw us back to God day in and day out. Have you ever smelled a smell that you haven't smelled for many years, but instantly, it takes you back in time to a pleasant memory? Your prayers should be like incense to God; they should be so familiar to Him that they immediately bring Him - His attention- back to you consistently and regularly. The Apostle Paul wrote in 1 Thessalonians 5:17, *Pray without ceasing*. God wants the beautiful fragrance of your prayers in His nostrils; and He never tires of it.
