The Pastor's Two Bits...

Welcome to Fairfield Glade First Baptist Church! Thank you for choosing to worship with us today! I hope you have a great experience with God as you offer your prayers and praise.

The story of Abraham's life takes up nearly 30% of the entire book of Genesis and about the same amount of the "Hall of Faith" in Hebrews 11. Other than Jesus, he might be the most significant person in the Bible. It was through Abraham that God chose to bless the world with a lineage leading to Jesus. In Genesis 12, God made a unique covenant with Abraham. It was a covenant of promise and blessing, not only for him personally, but for all generations after. That covenant is fulfilled in Jesus Christ.

Christianity was borne out of Judaism. The Old Testament scriptures tell us the history of the Hebrew people from their beginning through about 400 years before Jesus. Some of that history was glorious and victorious. Some... not so much. But it's important for us to understand Jewish history because it is our roots. There are examples, both good and bad, of what God expects of us. The Old Testament, through God's interaction with the Israelites tell us a lot about the character of God - His grace and patience and love; but also of His limits... He can only put up with sin and disobedience for so long.

The New Testament tells us about Jesus and the formation of the early church. And it assures us that we still serve the same God of the Old Testament Who has the same love and expectations. He wants us to see the examples of the Old Testament so that we can emulate the good and take heed of the bad. More than anything else, He wants us to be able to take full advantage of that original covenant He made with Abraham - that we be blessed through his lineage... through Jesus Christ.
