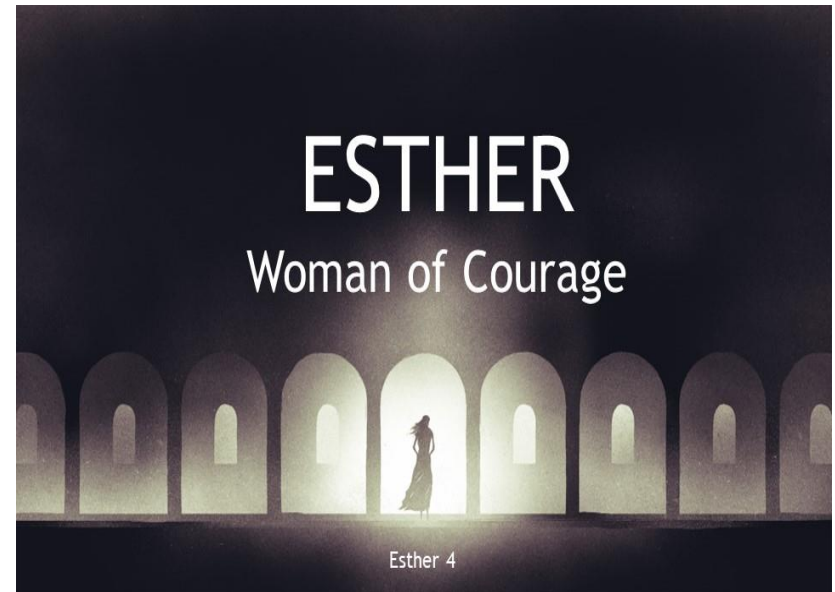

The Pastor's Two Bits...

Every civilization has defining moments - not necessarily short lengths of time, but periods that affect the very identity of who they become and are remembered as. They can be moments of strength or weakness, moments that lead to their rise among nations or their fall. One of the critical factors in societal health has to do with moral parameters and where a nation chooses to draw them from. For many centuries, Western Civilization (Europe and the Americas) has based its laws, ethics, and morality on Biblical -Christian- principles. But we are living in a defining moment. The underpinning of Christian influence in western culture has eroded. There is no longer an absolute standard of 'right and wrong'. There is no longer a foundational basis for law and order. This is precisely what happened to Old Testament Israel, it is the cause of the fall of the Roman Empire, and it is the source of the chaos that we are seeing in the streets of the great cities of America today. The first two of those examples destroyed themselves from within and in their weakness, were overrun by pagan invaders. History is still being written about the third one.

In defining moments such as this, Christians need to unite and stand firm on the Word of God and its application to society. We must actively oppose those who denigrate Christian principles, who promote immoral behavior, and who seek to enculturate our children in those things. We must oppose churches who embrace unBiblical perspectives, yet still claim to represent God. We must have the courage to stand for what is right in God's eyes regardless of the consequences. Queen Esther is a great Biblical example of doing just that...
