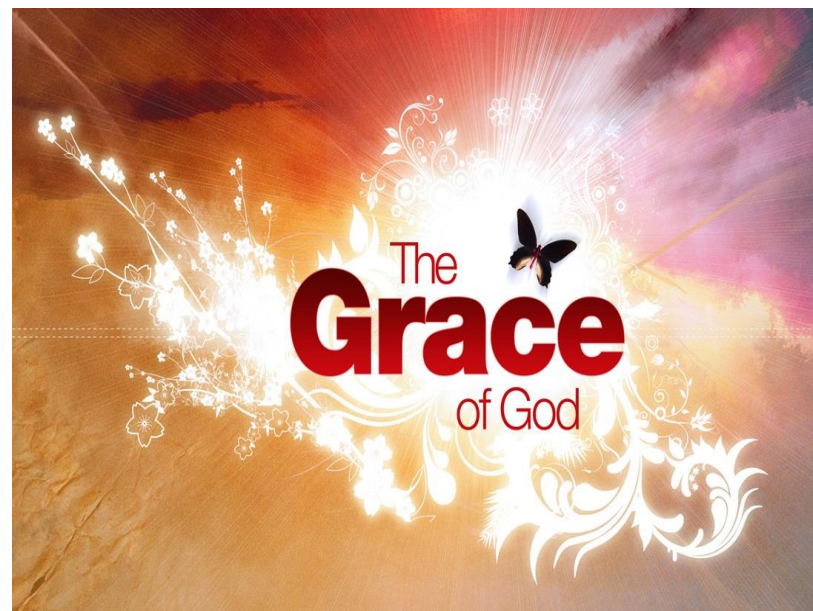

The Pastor's Two Bits...

Welcome to Fairfield Glade First Baptist Church! Thank you for choosing to worship with us today! I hope you have a great experience with God as you offer your prayers and praise.

Many of you know that I spent few weeks in Kazakhstan in 1991 when it was still part of the Soviet Union. While there, I was invited to attend a worship service at a local (and probably illegal) church. It was held in an old stone church building that no longer had windows in the openings where windows would normally have been. The seating was nothing more than planks of wood nailed to cut-off tree trunks about the diameter of a telephone pole. There was enough seating for about 200 people. It was a Sunday evening. Every seat was filled with mostly old women and children. The men stood all around wherever there was room and layers of people were outside, surrounding the building, some of whom were lucky enough to be by the window spaces, leaning in to hear and see. We were told that some were likely there to see Americans, which was an uncommon sight in Soviet Union. But we were also told that the church was usually filled to the brim when it met because worship like this was banned in the USSR and whenever the people got the chance, they loved getting together to sing to God and hear the Bible proclaimed. That is the only time in my life that I ever saw a church overflowing with people so excited about coming together for worship.

We were told that there were only 5 or 6 known believers among the Kazakh people at that time. This year, when Kay Lynn and I went back, we were told that there is somewhere between 50,000 and 150,000! What I witnessed in 1991 was the beginning of a great spiritual awakening in their country. It began with God-honoring, Bible-centered worship.

That would be a good start for any revival...
