### *The Pastor's Two Bits...*

Welcome to Fairfield Glade First Baptist Church! Thank you for choosing to worship with us today! I hope you have a great experience with God as you offer your prayers and praise.

Most of you know that I enjoy fishing. Well... actually, I enjoy catching! I cannot remember a time in life when I didn't fish. Mom and Dad were avid fishermen; not professional sorts, but mostly for food and fun. We fished lakes and rivers and small streams in the Ozarks of Missouri. We trout fished, bass fished, crappie fished; we caught lots of bluegill and other panfish. Every now and then we would bow fish. Sometimes we fished at night, but mostly during the day. Often times we went to a small stream where a distant relative owned land. My mom would get a hankering to go fishing during Sunday morning church service, so we would run home after church, change clothes, grab our fishing tackle and take off. We would stop on the way at Kentucky Fried Chicken and all of us get "two piece" meals (with cole slaw and mashed potatoes and gravy.) Sometimes Dad would go, sometimes my brothers, but often, just me and Mom. Those were my favorite fishing trips. Mom and I would wade down the stream together. She, fishing one side with her fly rod and me on the other side with my Zebco 202. We seldom caught anything big, but we always caught a lot! We knew, because we counted. Sometimes I got more, sometimes she did. But we always knew the count. Big or little if we pulled it out of the water, we counted it! Funny... I still count my fish to this day.

Jesus said, *Follow Me, and I will make you fishers of men.* The most important fishing we can do is to tell others about Jesus and invite them to church. People come in all shapes and types and sizes. They all need God. The Bible is our 'tackle'. Fairfield Glade and Cumberland County are small streams in relation to the lakes and rivers of the world. But there are lots of 'fish' to be caught here. We just need to get in the water, wade down the stream, and have some fun. Two weeks from today our revival services begin... It's time to start fishing!
