

The Pastor's Two Bits...

Welcome to Fairfield Glade First Baptist Church! Thank you for choosing to worship with us today! I hope you have a great experience with God as you offer your prayers and praise.

Reading the prophetic books of the Bible can sometimes be like reading our own newspapers. Old Testaments prophets consistently warned the nation of impending doom if they refused to turn back to God. Israel started out as one country. It began with Abraham, grew to into a people with 12 distinct tribes a few generations later. They eventually organized into a nation. Saul was its first king; David its second. David was a righteous man. Although he had plenty of sin that's mentioned in the Bible, he is still described as *a man after God's own heart*. Then came Solomon. Israel was still a unified nation. But after his reign, it fell apart. "Israel" broke away from "Judah". Israel was the "Northern Kingdom"; Judah was the "Southern Kingdom". From that time on, each of them had their own kings and operated independently from one another.

The Northern Kingdom never once had a king that pleased God. The very first one led them into idolatry and they never looked back. They lasted 208 years before God destroyed them. The Southern Kingdom had a mix of God-honoring kings and God-less ones. There were a couple of grand spiritual revivals through the years, but ultimately, they too, turned their backs on Him. They lasted 344 years.

Prophet after prophet spoke to them. But they turned deaf ears. They drew themselves further and further away from God and Godliness. In fact, they made fun of it. Isaiah 22 shows how far they had fallen. They ridiculed Isaiah's message - *Let us eat and drink, for tomorrow we shall die!* And they did. Isaiah described a country that is eerily similar to ours today.
