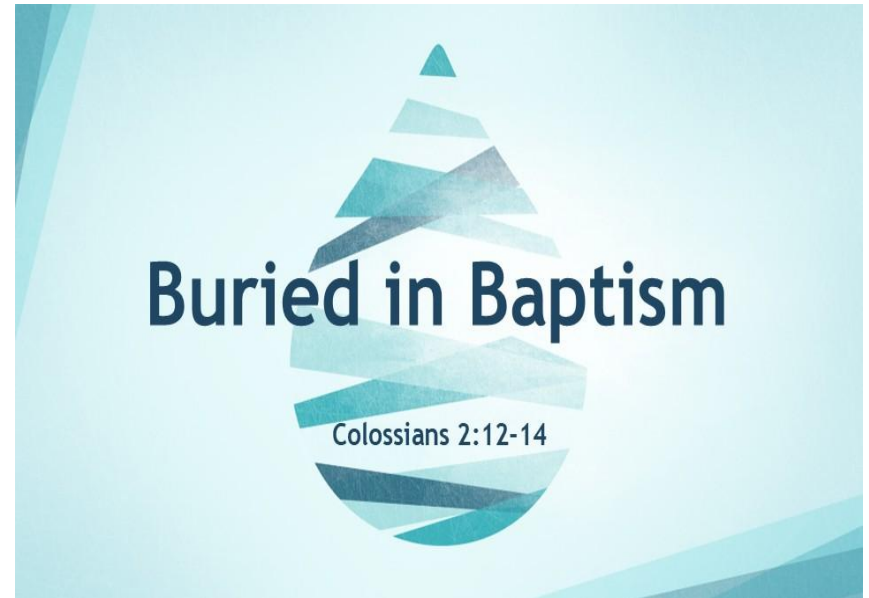

Welcome to Fairfield Glade First Baptist Church! Thank you for choosing to worship with us today! I hope you have a great experience with God as you offer your prayers and praise.

Baptism is an important symbol of Christian faith. It should signify commitment and submission of one's life to God. It is only valid after a person has repented of sin and recognized and accepted the Lordship of Jesus over their life. Here are some other things that baptism is and is not:

Baptism is...

- immersion in water as a symbol of Jesus' death, burial, and resurrection;
- identification with Jesus and other Christians;
- symbolic of the death of your old 'life' - your old habits and lifestyle (see 2 Corinthians 5:17); and
- a common act of obedience done by every Christian.

Baptism is not...

- an action that causes you to be saved. Repentance and submission of your life to God through Jesus Christ does that;
- a mere symbol. It is a symbol, but the symbolism of faith and obedience are more than just show;
- to be taken lightly. Jesus did it (Matthew 3:13-17). The Bible commands it (Acts 2:38). The church is charged with administering it (Matthew 28:19).

Jesus charged the church through the Great Commission to go into all the world, make disciples, and baptize them. My prayer is that FG FBC will do that faithfully - locally and globally.
